Dear Friends,

The theme of West Ohio Annual Conference is Unleashed! Proclaiming the Good News and Healing People Everywhere. As we prepare for Annual Conference, 2012, our Bishop Bruce Ough of the West Ohio Annual Conference has a word for us:

I'D LIKE TO MAKE THIS PERSONAL. Improving health globally begins with us right here in West Ohio; to impact Global Health we must also be healthy. I have begun a personal exercise and nutrition regimen designed to help me lose some weight and become a more healthy temple for the Lord. My ultimate goal is to get my borderline diabetes and high cholesterol under control. I AM CHALLENGING ALL WEST OHIO UNITED METHODISTS TO JOIN ME, particularly the lay and clergy members of the conference.

YOU CAN DO SO BY JOINING ME IN WALKING TO THE FOUR CORNERS OF THE WORLD OVER THE NEXT FOUR MONTHS. Each of our four mission partnerships is in a different corner of the world. It is a cumulative total of 27,090 miles from the Conference Center in Worthington to Monterrey (Mexico), Ho Chi Minh City (Vietnam), Samara (Russia), Kamina (Congo) and back to Lakeside. On February 12, 2012 (my 61st birthday) I will begin to log my miles to the four corners of the world. I will post my progress on the West Ohio Conference website at www.westohioumc.org and on our West Ohio Facebook page at www.facebook.com/westohioumc. I hope hundreds of you will join me in walking and also posting your progress online. Together, we may be able to walk to the four corners of the world multiple times before the last day of this challenge June 12 - four months from February 12.

WHILE I WALK, I WILL BE PRAYING. I will be praying for Jesus' ministry of healing to become deeply imbedded in my life and the life of each of our congregations. I will be praying for solidarity with God's children around the world - most of whom have no mode of transportation but walking. I will be praying for each of our four partnerships. I will be praying for Holy Spirit breakthroughs of health, vitality and renewal in each of our West Ohio churches. I invite you to fully engage in this PRAYER WALK for personal and global health.

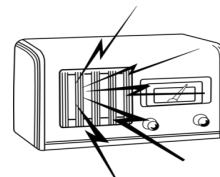
